



Health and Safety Guidelines for Bundle and Sing Flex Pass for Outdoor Classes

In consideration of the COVID-19 pandemic and the health and safety of all of families who attend Music Together® classes in person we will be following guidelines as set by the State of CT as well as the CDC for outdoor events.

1. Before every class, participants will be required to fill out in this basic health screening consisting of these 5 questions which will be texted to you:
 - *Do you currently have any symptoms of a cold or flu?
 - *Have you or anyone in your household been diagnosed with the COVID- 19 virus?
 - *Have you traveled internationally (or just travelled) in the last 14 days?
 - *Have you or anyone in your household been directed to self-quarantine?
 - * Have you checked your child's temperature before you leave the house? If it is above 100.4 please refrain from attending class on that day.
2. Please refrain from attending class you've been diagnosed with coronavirus, if you or your child(ren) have been in close proximity to someone who has recently had the coronavirus, if you or your children are feeling sick, have a fever, a cough, or are experiencing general difficulty breathing.
3. If you or anyone in your family have been in close contact as defined by the state of CT with a person who has tested positive after attending an MTFC class or at any time during the semester, you are required to report that immediately to our office by text or email.
4. Please wash your hands frequently, and before and after attending our classes. We recommend that our hosts have a sanitization station in place with hand sanitizer and alcohol wipes. We also recommend that every family bring their own hand sanitizer as well.
5. During class, children and adults will be required to maintain a minimum of a 6-foot distance between themselves and other participants who are not in the same family or

other cohort. This could be challenging as children naturally tend to be social and it was not the norm in the past during our classes! However, we will be asking every family to be responsible to keep the appropriate distance with their children. Please be aware of this guideline and help us to maintain it!

6. Children will not be required to wear masks.

7. Adults shall wear a surgical style face mask or other covering for their nose and mouth if within 6 ft of those who are not in the same household, unless doing so would be contrary to his or her health or safety due to medical conditions, and except when eating.

8. The Music Together Teacher will be teaching from a 12 ft distance in relationship to the participants. Should they leave that 12 ft radius they will be wearing a mask.

9. Bathroom Use - the host requires that any family that wishes to use an indoor bathroom will use a mask.

10. Instruments or other objects will not be shared. Families will be advised about what to bring from home for instruments or props. Instrument sets are available for sale on our website under "Store."

11. Weather – All groups will have until the end of February to use their flex pass classes. Each group will work with their teacher to schedule classes around the projected weather as deemed acceptable by the host and the group with no less than 48hr notice provided to the teacher.

12. There will be no refunds or cancellations for Bundle and Sing Flex Passes. As this is a group rate, there will be no refunds for individual families who do not continue with the class. There will be no refunds for unused classes due to the flexibility of the pass.

WHAT YOU NEED TO BRING FOR YOUR OUTDOOR MUSIC TOGETHER CLASS

1. A WATERPROOF BLANKET OR SOMETHING TO SIT ON

2. APPROPRIATE CLOTHING/ATTIRE FOR THE WEATHER – Please note that we may need to “Bundle” our children and ourselves in order to be comfortable.

3. HAND SANITIZER

4. INSTRUMENTS FOR THE DAY: Please bring your instruments to class every week along with your songbook for class. Keep the instruments in a bag until the teacher asks you to bring them out for a specific activity. Instrument sets can be purchased on our website, or you can bring home made instruments. Children and adults will not be sharing instruments.
